- Representative Survey in Germany with n=1.002 Interviewees
- Population: German-speaking population between the ages of 18 and 69
- Survey duration: 4 minutes








## What are Sinus-Milieus®?

The Sinus-Milieus are considered the gold standard of target group segmentation.



The Sinus-Milieu models all have a very similar graphical structure ("potato graphic"). The vertical axis shows the social situation and the horizontal axis the value orientation. The higher a milieu is located, the higher its education, income, and occupational group; the further to the right, the more modern its basic sociocultural orientation.

## The Sinus-Milieus are a model of society.

The Sinus-Milieus were developed by SINUS over 40 years ago. They group people with similar values and a comparable social situation into "groups of like-minded people". The transitions between the milieus are fluid. We call this the "uncertainty principle of everyday reality".

The Sinus-Milieus illustrate what moves the various lifeworlds (values, lifestyles) - and how they can be moved (media and communication preferences). Products, brands, parties, media, etc. can be positioned in the milieu map.








## Important problems- Animal suffering due to the use of animals Very important(37%)



To what extent do you think the interests and needs of animals are sufficiently represented in politics?



To what extent do you think the interests and needs of animals are sufficiently represented in politics?














## And what do you think, should there be a Federal Ministry for Animal Welfare?- Yes (64%)












## Strengthening the Animal Welfare Act(58%)













Animal welfare tax on meat, eggs and milk, which can be used to finance animal welfare measures, for example(19%)





## Germany should do more in the EU to implement high animal welfare standards throughout Europe - Totally agree(41%)



















Imagine it was a federal election. To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements?




Imagine it was a federal election. To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements?




## How would you best characterize your eating habits?

Vegan / Vegetarian (7%)





## Summary

Animal welfare is important to people in Germany. Animal suffering caused by the use of animals is an important problem for 73% of the German population.

In particular, the improvement of the animal welfare laws and their enforcement is considered important, but also labeling and transparency.

The more animal welfare also has implications on people purchasing power (e.g. not eating meat or higher prices for meat consumption), the lower the approval rating.

Attitudes towards animal welfare are closely linked to people's fundamental values.
